


Happy New Year Kiowa County!

- Radon test kits - \$8.50 per kit
- Neutroleum Alpha 8 oz bottles - \$40.00 per bottle
 - a commercial perfume compound primarily used as a powerful odor neutralizer, especially for strong smells like skunk spray, dead animals, or kennel odors, masking them with a pleasant, minty scent. While effective for surfaces and air, it doesn't chemically neutralize the sulfur compounds in skunk musk but rather covers them up.
